Background:

These projects were funded to address of challenges experienced by the schools in the rural parts of Eastern Cape and Limpopo where the disadvantaged communities still struggle with the basic right to sanitation.

The cases of 6-year-old Micheal Komape of Mahlodumela Primary School in Limpopo, and Lumka Mkhethwa, a 5-year-old Grade R pupil at Luna Primary School in the Eastern Cape, who tragically passed away in 2014 and 2018 respectively because of the inhumane conditions of the “pit toilets” in their schools.

As a result of the empowering provisions of the Lotteries Act 57 of 1997, as amended which permits direct intervention in the form of pro-active funding, the NLC saw it fit to intervene and respond to this worthy good cause.
